



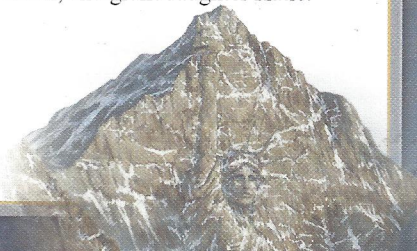
IN LOVING MEMORY

Lt. Col. Warren William Wendt

Warren was born and raised in St. Paul, Minnesota. After graduating High School in 1944, he entered Coe College in Cedar Rapids, Iowa for Army Specialized Training Reserve Program. He attended the University of Minnesota and on June 12, 1948 he graduated U of M, was married and was comissioned 2nd Lt. in the U.S. Air Force. He was an Electrical Assembly officer and transferred for three years to England where his daughter, Mary Ellen was born. He was then transferred to New Mexico working at the Special Weapons Center at Kirtland AFB where his son, William was born. In 1959 he transferred to the Ballistic Missile Division in Los Angeles to the Titan Program Office responsibe for developing and acquisition of training equipment for the crews for Titan I and II missile assembly and launch. He earned his Master of Science Degree in Engineering Psychology at Purdue University in 1963. He returned to Los Angeles and then transferred to Andrews AFB and served on the President's Space Shuttle program. He retired from the Air Force in 1974 to Temecula, CA where he lived for the last 40+ years. He organized a small MG club in the South Bay and co-founded an annual event for MG owners in the Western States: the GoF, the Gathering of the Faithful. His pride and joy was his 1952 MG TD which he restored twice. He is surived by his wife, Bernice, daughter Mary Ellen, and granddaughter Katie.
