



Day Camp will run for 8 weeks this summer, starting June 30th and last day- August 22nd.

Ages: 6-12 years (turning 6,7,8,9,10,11,12 in 2025)

Cost: \$120/week per child

\$230/week for 2 children in the same household

A \$25/child non-refundable registration fee MUST be paid within 24 hours of registration confirmation.

REGISTRATION: step 1 will be to get your place in our day camp queue. This is done On-line only. A link to the queue will be placed on our Facebook page, as well as on our website. **Goulds Recreation CANNOT take registration over the phone, by email or in person. We CANNOT bypass registration links.**

Additional Information on Day Camp Registration:

Goulds Rec strives to be as fair as possible when it comes to registering for programs. We believe in the first come first serve policy and will continue to follow this format. Parents/guardians can only register their own child(ren) for our day camp program. A parent/guardian under their on-line registration, CANNOT register a child from a different family/household. If it is noticed that this has taken place, registration for the child not within your family/household will become void.

Goulds Rec staff have no access to bypass the on-line system and we have no control over who gains access first to our on-line system. Our day camp program is extremely popular with more than 100 families trying to get one of our limited spots for camp at the exact same time. ***We will not be answering phones or checking/returning messages either through phone or Facebook or replying to emails for the first 2 hours of open registration.*** Please be patient! We will be in touch!

ON-LINE REGISTRATION for our Summer Sports and Programs: Begins 9am, Wednesday, May 7th, 2025. Link will be available on our Facebook page, as well as on our Website – www.gouldsrecreation.com . The link will be called **Goulds Rec 2025 Summer Sports & Programs Registration**

We cannot take registration over the phone. Fees will be due 2 week prior to program start date. Payment holds your child's spot for the program. Payment is not made through our on-line registration. We accept e-transfers to gouldsrecreg@gmail.com. In the message section of the transfer, it is very important to type your child's name and the program you are registering them for. In person cash payments can be arranged.

NOTICE: *Goulds Recreation is affiliated with Softball NL and follow their directions/guidelines for our minor softball program.*

We are exploring a slightly different path this year with our Softball Program. If there are enough players and coaches, we will have Fastpitch available to teams in the u11, U13, U15 and U17 that will compete in tournaments, including provincials (tryouts will be required for team selections).

We are looking at a slo-pitch format, learn to play while playing layout. This will be for children/youth from ages U5, U7, U9 and for U11, U13, should the interest be there. In order for this to happen, we require higher numbers in registration and parent/guardian volunteers to assist our counselors. We will also explore entering the Softball NL Jamboree's and slo-pitch provincials as long as we have enough to play and volunteer coaches.

COST: U5 Age group: \$50 Other Ages: \$100 (1st child); \$95 (each additional child in same family)

This includes your Softball NL affiliation fee

**Additional costs will be applicable for athletes who participate or compete in games/tournaments outside of our regular house program and/or for clinics.*

Registration for softball will be to gauge interest. In the registration link, under the softball section, we will look for feedback. While this is not directly registration, if we are able to offer what we are proposing, those who have completed this feedback will be given priority to register.

How does it work? Every Monday morning at 8am, an email will go out to our eligible participant list about the upcoming Friday event. Direct replies to that email will be the only ones considered for the limited spots. Spots will be filled in order of replies, with payment due by the end of Monday.

Monday's registration is ONLY for participants in at least 1 Goulds Rec summer program.

After Monday registration, if there are remaining spots available, we will open registration to the public on Tuesday morning. We will post on our Facebook page the event for that Friday, with directions to email us if you would like a spot for your child. The remaining spots will be filled in order of emails received that are requesting a spot. Payment will be required by the end of Tuesday to hold your child's spot. The registration for each Friday closes at 11:30pm on that Tuesday, or when spaces fill (whichever comes first). **SPACE IS LIMITED! Payment confirms spot!**

Time of Event: Will follow the same format as our Day Camp! Participants can be dropped off as early as 8am and picked up as late as 5:30pm! Drop-off and Pick-up are at the Rec Centre.

Cost: \$25/participant in a Goulds Rec Program; \$30/participant for general public

****Your child will be participating with our Day Camp on these Fridays.** Number of spots available depends on the event planned. Including day camp participants, we can have 70+ participants on Fridays. **What will your child need to bring?** Definitely a fully packed lunch and snacks (no refrigeration or heating on site), plenty to drink (reusable water bottles are ideal), Sun Screen, proper clothing/footwear for the day, hat and a change of clothes. Ensure to label all belongings!

**Children registered in our Day Camp program are
already registered for the Friday events that fall on their weeks at Day Camp.**

Goulds Rec Refund Policy:

All refunds for Goulds Rec programs will be subject to a \$15 administration fee. Full refunds will only be issued if Goulds Rec cancels a program/event. A 2-week notice of cancellation of programming 4+ weekslong must be provided. Refunds will not be issued for 2-3 week programs or for special events.

Day Camp requires a two-week notice (2 weeks prior to the week(s) cancelling) to cancel.
