

Joe Delmar Truemner, 74 of Pigeon, passed away Saturday, December 26, 2015 at his home.

He was born February 28, 1941 in Winsor Township, son of Delmar J. and Edna B. (Haag) Truemner, and graduated from Pigeon High School in 1959. He received his Bachelors degree from Central Michigan University in 1963, and his Masters degree in 1969.

Joe taught in Berkley for three years, then taught at various military bases in the Philippines, Germany, Turkey, Okinawa, and Cuba. After returning home, he taught at Davenport and Baker Colleges.

Joe was a lifetime member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Linkville.
