
OMET SIDING SPR CONCEPTUAL ILLUSTRATION OF POSSIBLE ATMOSPHERIC COLLISIONS

According to NASA's calculations, comet Siding Spring C/2013 A1 will pass extremely close to the planet Mars on October 19, 2014. The illustrations below will show an approximate depiction of a top view of the solar system when the comet reaches perihelion with Mars. Although the comet is not expected to directly collide with the planet, the atmospheres of each may interact to a certain degree due to the comet's close proximity. Comets have been known to collide with planets as with Jupiter in 1994. It will almost exactly 20 years since the Shoemaker-Levy comet broke apart and slammed into Jupiter. Such a collision of atmospheres could produce an electromagnetic 'light show'. Comets do collide also with the Sun as the gravitational pull exerted on the comet changes its trajectory and are vaporized. Thus although a slight probability, there could be a change in the comet's course that could allow for the comet to directly impact the surface of the planet. Several unique properties are illustrated about comet Siding Spring that have a peculiar association to comet ISON and the infamous Mayan Doomsday calendar still. Also, during the Hybrid solar eclipse of Nov 3, 2013, comet ISON also has a unique numerical factor in that 666 days from ISON's perihelion on Nov 28, 2013 corresponds to the end of the Tetrad series of 2014-15 in between Rosh HaShana and Sukkot. The other peculiarity is that the difference between the distance of Siding Spring's distance to Mars is the difference between ISON's tail length compared to the distance of the Earth to the Moon. Prophetically what could all this mean, for one, it is a Heavily Sign that based on interpretations of the Mazzaroth, the timing depicts a message that when World War III occurs, i.e., sudden destruction, there will be a harvest of the Bride of Christ in tandem.
