The focus of the meeting was on the police report, commissioned by Police Dept. for \$25,000. There were two speakers, both opposing the report: Betty Sue Ester, Junad Riski. He railed on Wally as usual. Betty Sue was about the Report.

The video report as presented by Vick? said research about one ward missing? The rest of the report centered on internal staffing of the Department. Some of the internal departments are out of balance with each other. Ie. One area would have 2 sergeants, others no sergeants. They recommended balancing personnel more efficiently and effectively. Presenter said also that Eddington's tenure is a long one, ten years. He will retire at year's end. Eddington suggested that there may be a few professional differences with the report, but he was enthusiastic about it. The new Chief will implement any changes that are made.
