

The church I grew up in had a tradition of a Sunrise service at 6:30 am on Easter morning and following that service, there was an Easter breakfast. As a young child I really looked forward to this worship service (not because of the early start time) but because the

service was led by the middle and high school students. As a young student, I enjoyed seeing the older students leading and participating in the service. Reading, praying, singing, and giving the message (which was usually a skit) were all parts of the service that were youth led and I thought it was so cool that they were all up front and I couldn't wait to be old enough to participate. Each year, I anticipated the Easter sunrise service, looking forward to the year I could first participate.

Church Council:

Recently Bob Campbell resigned as President of the church council, therefore Brad Stevenson is now serving as President and Dale Retrum is now serving as the Vice President. An additional council member will soon be appointed.

The Church Council recently approved recommendations brought forward from committees for expenditures from two of the church funds. The Worship & Music Committee brought a proposal to update and add audio & visual equipment in the sanctuary, to be paid for from monies from the Memorial Fund. The Property Committee brought a proposal to replace the HVAC units for Bachman Hall and Fireside Room, to be paid for from monies from the designated Capital Improvement Fund (Verizon monies). Both of these proposals were approved by the Church Council and are moving forward. Paper Rollers are also contributing money for some of the additional audio equipment for the sanctuary. The Committees and Church Council extend many thanks for the utilization of these funds to pay for these projects and capital improvements, this wouldn't be possible without the contributions made to the Memorial Fund and the volunteers who participate in Paper Rollers.

Volunteer Opportunity:

Some of the Audio Visual equipment in the sanctuary will soon be updated and enhanced and with this new equipment, there will be a training session to go over the operation of the new equipment. We thought this might be a good time to see if there are others in the congregation who might like to volunteer to operate the AV equipment during worship. Many thanks to our small but mighty crew of current AV volunteers...your faithful service is very much appreciated. If you are interested in learning more or would like to volunteer, please talk to any of the following people: Ron Clausen, Ken Johnson, or Pastor Jennifer. The training session will be scheduled once the equipment is installed and operational...look for future announcements for the date and time.

Easter Celebration Preparation:

There will be an Easter Egg Hunt following worship on Easter Sunday for the children...to help get ready for this annual event, we're looking for donations of plastic eggs to fill, small individually wrapped candy or toys to put inside the plastic eggs. The Gary Family will again be coordinating this event and they ask that the donations be brought to the church by Palm Sunday, April 14.


