

CASHA Scholarship Award Program

General Information:

CASHA awards one college scholarship each year in the amount of \$500.00 to the CASHA juvenile high point rider. Rules and eligibility are outlined below. The winner will need to contact Stacey Kipper at 303-619-8699 or Stacey0975@aol.com to receive a check which will be made payable directly to the college of his/her choice. The winner will be announced each year at the CASHA Year End Awards banquet.

Eligibility:

- Rider must be a member in good standing of CASHA
- Rider must be 17 years of age as of December 1 of the previous year per USEF rules at the time the award is made
- Rider may currently be enrolled in High School or College
- Points count only for those shows in which the rider is a member in good standing of CASHA
- Points will follow rider ONLY; horses do not have to be owned by a CASHA member
- Only one horse is required to fill a class to make it official

Qualifying Shows:

- Colorado Classic Horse Show
- Almost Summer Horse Show
- Denver Queen City Horse Show
- Any other horse show which applies for and is granted approval by CASHA during the show season

Point System for Scholarship Award:

Scholarship point categories are to be determined by the CASHA board and currently include but are not limited to the following:

- 5 Gaited – Open, Amateur, Juvenile
- 3 Gaited – Open, Amateur, Juvenile
- Fine Harness – Open, Amateur
- Park – Open, Amateur
- Park Pleasure – Open, Amateur, Juvenile
- Show Pleasure – Juvenile (riding & driving), 5 Gaited
- Country Pleasure – Juvenile (riding & driving), Western, Hunter
- Equitation – Age Group and Pleasure

Most classes count toward the scholarship award. Classes that do NOT count toward the scholarship award include but are not limited to: Novice, Maiden, Limit, Ladies, Junior Horse, Divisions by sex of horse, and/or Divisions by height of horse. Also classes that do NOT count are classes that restrict previous winners which include but are not limited to: UPHA Challenge Cup (except 10 & Under Walk & Trot), Saddle & Bridle's ASB Shatner Western Pleasure Class (except Hunt Seat Classic), Saddle & Bridle's Pleasure Equitation Medallion, USEF Medal classes, etc.

Disclaimer:

- The winner's check will be available for one year following the banquet
- If a college/university is not chosen and/or attended by the winner within one year, then the scholarship funds are null and void
- Scholarship money may only be paid directly to a college/university or trade school and will NOT be paid directly to the winner
- Age of the individual will be determined by the age the individual on December 1 of the previous year (to follow USEF age rules)
- If there is no winner in a particular year (i.e. no individuals 17 years of age participating in a given year), the award will simply not be given in that year
- In the case of no award in a given year, funds will NOT roll over or compound for the next year
- Each year only one prize of \$500.00 will be given
- A coin will be tossed in the event of a tie
