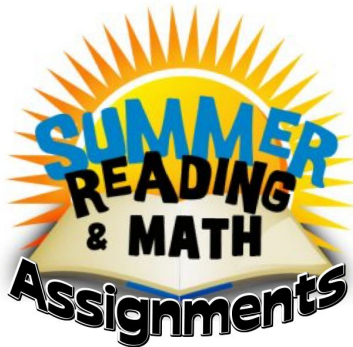

Information should be in phrases, not sentences. Please do not use a report cover, but do staple this form to your outline. Grade includes grammar and spelling.
