North Carolina Insurance Updates - August 2020

We would like to alert all providers to some updates for North Carolina.

- The current COVID-19 accommodations are extended through October 31, 2020.
- Under North Carolina Administrative Code 11 NCAC 06A .0813, providers become inactive when at least one course is not offered during a calendar year. However, due to COVID-19, no provider will be made inactive for not offering a course in 2020. Prometric and North Carolina will re-evaluate in 2021 to determine when the process will resume.
- We ask that all providers review their approved course listings. North
  Carolina continuing education courses do not expire, and all courses no
  longer available to students should be removed. Please compile a list of all
  courses that need to be inactivated and send to

- The North Carolina CE Provider Information Packet was updated in January 2020. Please review the packet so you are up to date on the most current information.
