Bloomfield Police Department Monthly Report for March 2019

This is the monthly report for the Month of March 2019 from the Bloomfield Police Department. It is the police department's goal to keep the citizens of Bloomfield Township/Village informed as to the police department's activities, statistics, and community projects. It is very important that the citizens be aware of the various concerns that have and are occurring within our community.

On Sunday, March 3rd at approximately 2:07pm officers executed a traffic stop in the area Hwy U and Hwy 12 for a traffic infraction. At the conclusion of the stop a 23-year-old female was issued a traffic citation for operating after suspension.

On Wednesday, March 6th at approximately 5:34pm officers received a physical abuse of a child complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a 29-year-old male was arrested and confined in the Walworth County jail. A charge of physical abuse of a child was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Sunday, March 10th at approximately 12:26am officers received a criminal damage to property complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation three counts of criminal damage to property and a bail jumping charge were referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's office for a 17-year-old male offender.

On Friday, March 15th at approximately 1:07pm officers responded to the area of Hwy H and Lake Geneva Hwy for a report of a possible impaired driver. At the conclusion of the investigation a 24-year-old male was arrested and confined in the Walworth County jail for operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated 1st offense.

On Friday, March 15th at approximately 7:18pm officers executed a traffic stop in the area of Hwy 50 and Eastside Road for a traffic infraction. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 35-year-old male was issued traffic citations for a speeding violation and operating a motor vehicle after suspension.

On Friday, March 15th at approximately 8:52pm officers executed a traffic stop on Hwy 12 in the area of Clover Road for an equipment violation. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 21-year-old female was issued a traffic citation for operating after suspension.

On Saturday, March 16th at approximately 5:42pm officers executed a traffic stop on Center Drive in the area of Hwy U for a traffic infraction. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 47-year-old female was issued a traffic citation for operating after suspended.

On Wednesday, March 20th at approximately 2:04pm officers responded to the area of Hillside Blvd and Greenview Road for a report of a hit & run property damage only crash. At the conclusion of the investigation a 47-year-old female was issued traffic citations for hit & run property adjacent to highway and deviation from designated lane. Additionally, a criminal charge of operating after revocation was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Tuesday March 26th at approximately 3:06pm officers responded to a suspicious vehicle/persons complaint in the 1200 block of Pell Lake Road. At the conclusion of the investigation a 44-year-old female was arrested and confined in the Walworth County jail. Charges of disorderly conduct and resisting/obstructing a police officer have been forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office. Additionally, a 45-year-old male was issued a non-traffic citation for resisting/obstructing a police officer.

During the month of March 2019, the police department affected 110 arrests for various violations of Bloomfield Municipal Ordinances and Wisconsin State Statutes compared 246 arrests during the month of March 2018.
