



Easy Breezy Reading (EBR) gives children extra practice reading and spelling their letters and phonics using games and structured literacy

Easy Read English is designed to practice English reading and writing skills. Often, our texts are simplified Bible Stories and songs based upon their EBR lessons.



Who can come? Any student in grades 1-4 or any older child who needs to strengthen early elementary reading and spelling skills. Parents who would like to improve their English are also welcome! We limit our number of students to four children per one adult volunteer. We accept children from any denomination or none, gender, race, or age.

When do you meet? We have two identical options: YMCA in Navarre on Tuesdays from 2:15 – 3:45. Or Holley By the Sea recreation center in Navarre on Wednesdays from 3:45-5:15. The compatible follow-up lessons are at Compass Community Church at the Holley By the Sea club house by the bay on Sundays at 9:30-10:30. We offer even more learning and play during the service at 10:30-11:30. We ask parents to stay on Sundays, but you can participate in the adult Sunday School options and church service.

How much is it? There is no charge. Donations for snacks or supplies are accepted!

What program do you use? Easy Breezy Reading is for those needing basic K-2 skills. Who teaches the children? Our volunteers are Christians who are trained, screened, and meet the requirements of our Child Protection Policy.

What is your program schedule: "Off Campus" groups (not meeting on Sundays) will use multi-sensory techniques through PPTs, worksheets, games, and activities to learn new sounds (phonograms) and words that do not follow phonetic patterns. On Sundays, we add Bible stories based on the phonograms they just learned along with games, songs, prayers, and prizes.

Can parents observe or help? YES! Any parent is welcome, and we encourage it. Parents who could use some reminders of their phonics are encouraged to participate as a Family Literacy partner.

Homework Helper: We assign your child an adult who will call the parent's phone (or you can arrange Skype, FaceTime, or Zoom) one or two times a week. These mini lessons will review word lists and take 30-45 minutes. We ask the parent to be present during the homework sessions.

What time should I pick up my child? Please come promptly after the lesson, unless your child is in the after-school program. In the warm months, we hope to swim after class. We will not release your child to anyone not listed on the registration form. If we don't recognize that person, we may ask for photo ID. If you send someone else to pick up your child, please make arrangements with us earlier. We have guidelines to meet as far as adult-student ratio.
