CALL TO ORDER


Mayor Gwin called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Commissioner Brecheisen-Huss joined in via conference call.

REGULAR BUSINESS


- Consideration of structure movement. City Attorney Solander reviewed documentation and all documentation was sufficient other than the contractor missing a signature line on the form which would need to be signed in front of a notary public.
- City Manager Weiner commented he felt comfortable moving forward tentative on the contractor coming in to sign the bond in front of a notary public. Mayor Gwin asked if City Staff has any other concerns other than the bond. City Manager Weiner mentioned the concern of the 48-hour application time frame as required by City Code and setting a precedent for future instances. He also mentioned this is more of a procedural issue and currently requires the Commission to approve however this is something that could be addressed in the city code and could be handled administratively by the City Manager.
- Commissioner Brecheisen-Huss and Commissioner Cole both agreed this was something the City Manager should be able to handle and is more of a procedural matter. The Governing Body expressed the desire to amend the 48-hour application time frame upon passage of the updated City Code to allow for more flexibility at the discretion of City staff. Mayor Gwin made a motion to approve the paperwork to move the structure upon obtaining the required signature. Commissioner Cole seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

With no further business to come before the commission, Mayor Gwin adjourned the meeting at 5:21 p.m.
