WARREN COUNTY (PEQUEST RIVER) MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

MINUTES November 18, 2024

Chairwoman Napolitani called the regular meeting of the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Authority's Administration Building located at 199 Foul Rift Road, Belvidere, New Jersey.

Chairwoman Napolitani led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance and read the Introductory Statement.

MINUTES

Ms. Skoog moved, and Mr. Roth seconded to approve the minutes of the October 15, 2024 regular meeting, as presented. All in favor, motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

Chairwoman Napolitani recapped the correspondence listed below:

- 1. Notice by Ronald S. Heymann, Attorney for Applicant, Trinity Point Properties, LLC, for a hearing before the Belvidere Planning Board in the Town of Belvidere, County of Warren, for a minor site plan approval on the premises located at 304 Front Street and designated as Block 16, Lot 2 on the Town of Belvidere Tax Map.
- 2. Letter dated October 23, 2024 to WC(PR)MUA requesting utility service from French & Parrello Associates, for the Oxford Townhomes project, together with a copy of the utility plans and a flow summary report.
- 3. Letter dated October 28, 2024 to French & Parrello Associates from John Inscho, Executive Director of WC(PR)MUA advising that the Oxford plant has sufficient capacity and flow to accommodate the Oxford Townhomes project.

SERVICE AREA UPDATES

Belvidere: Mr. Roth had no updates to report.

Oxford: Mr. Norton was not in attendance.

White Twp.: Ms. Skoog had no updates to report.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Donati and/or Mr. Wilkinson were not in attendance; however, their report was included in the agenda packets and reviewed. There were no questions or comments.

CFO'S REPORT

Mr. Francisco summarized his monthly financial report.

Mr. Francisco discussed the Annual Metered Wastewater Flow chart which was distributed to the Board prior to the meeting. In addition, he provided and summarized the 2024 Billing Worksheet and 2024 White Billing Breakdown.

The residential user rate will increase in 2025 to \$12.50 per billing unit and the industrial rate will be \$25.00. At next month's Budget Hearing the Board will formally vote on the rates for 2025.

In addition, Mr. Francisco discussed the Calculation of Connection Fees for 2025 report, which was provided to the Board. He explained that we could charge \$12,264.00 per customer to hook up to our system. The Board agreed to increase the connection fee to \$7,000.00.

Mr. Francisco explained that for the I-Bank Funding Plan for the Belvidere improvements, a Bond Counsel is necessary. Therefore, he presented the Board with a Resolution authorizing the professional services contract with McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC for Bond Counsel Services. Mr. Roth moved to authorize said professional services. Ms. Skoog seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Mr. Tipton was not in attendance.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

WOMEN . .

Mr. Inscho advised that Operator Walters left to take another job elsewhere. Therefore, the position of the fifth operator needs to be filled. Mr. Inscho further advised that Dave Berger, who currently works for the Town of Belvidere, is interested in the position. He also has experience in mechanical work, i.e. changing the oil and maintaining the vehicles, mowers and equipment, so we would not have to send our vehicles out for service.

Mr. Inscho requested a motion to hire Dave Berger at \$30.00 per hour. Ms. Skoog moved, and Mr. Roth seconded to approve the hiring of Dave Berger as the fifth operator/mechanic. All in favor, the motion passed.

Chairwoman Napolitani inquired as to the progress with the garage (Belvidere plant). Mr. Inscho advised that it should be delivered on December 17, 2024 and he was told it would take three days to put it up.

FINANCE

Ms. Skoog moved that Resolution #24-32 (Certificate No. 459: \$71,184.95) be approved to pay all bills from the Operating Fund, as presented. Mr. Roth seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

Ms. Skoog moved that Resolution #24-33 (Certificate No. 463: \$7,102.25) be approved to pay all bills from the Capital Improvements Fund as presented. Mr. Roth seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

AUTHORITY CHAIRWOMAN

Chairwoman Napolitani had nothing to report this month.

RESOLUTION OF THE WARREN COUNTY (PEQUEST RIVER) MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH MCMANIMON, SCOTLAND & BAUMANN, LLC FOR BOND COUNSEL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") was duly created by ordinance of the County of Warren, New Jersey, as a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey and has been organized and is existing under the Municipal and County Utilities Authorities Law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1957 of the State of New Jersey and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the Authority shall have the power to borrow money and issue its bonds and other obligations and to provide for the rights of the holders of its bonds and other obligations, as provided in the Act, for the purpose of financing the cost of various projects; and

WHEREAS, the Authority wishes to undertake certain infrastructure improvements and to finance same through the environmental infrastructure financing program (the "New Jersey Water Bank") of the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (the "I-Bank"); and

WHEREAS, in order to finance the cost of such infrastructure improvements through the I-Bank, the Authority has a need for bond counsel legal services (the "Bond Counsel Services"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:11-1 *et seq.* (the "LPCL"), the Authority has the power to award contracts necessary for the efficient operation of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC ("MS&B") is one of the leading firms in the nation in the area of public finance, consistently ranking first in the State of New Jersey in volume of bond issues, par amount of bond issues, or both, by Thompson Reuters, with a deep history of representing municipalities, counties and municipal utility and sewerage authorities issuing bonds and notes through the I-Bank; and

WHEREAS, MS&B has provided the Authority with a proposed fee agreement setting forth the manner and costs of performing the Bond Counsel Services, a copy of which is on file with the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority wishes to enter into such fee agreement (the "Contract") with MS&B for a term to expire either within one (1) year after the effective date of such Contract or upon the completion of the Bond Counsel Services and all related tasks, whichever is earlier, for an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to be paid in accordance with the rates set forth in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Authority hereby certifies that it has funds available to compensate MS&B for the Bond Counsel Services, including by financing the cost of such services as part of any I-Bank financing; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the LPCL, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i), the Bond Counsel Services are professional services exempt from public bidding; and

WHEREAS, notice of the award of the Contract shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- Section 1. The recitals hereto are hereby incorporated herein as if set forth at length.
- Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes a professional services contract with MS&B for a term to expire either within one (1) year after the effective date of such agreement, or upon the completion of the Bond Counsel Services and all related tasks, whichever is earlier, for a contract amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to be paid in accordance with the rates and terms and conditions set forth in the Contract.
- Section 3. The Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Executive Director and/or the Secretary of the Authority are hereby authorized to execute the Contract awarded herein and any and all other documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution, together with such additions, deletions and modifications as deemed necessary and/or desirable in consultation with counsel to the Authority.
- Section 4. The Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Executive Director and/or the Secretary of the Authority are hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate this Resolution in consultation with counsel to the Authority.
 - Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
