Who is eligible?

Must be a female Saginaw County high school freshman, sophomore, or junior playing a freshman, junior varsity or varsity sport. The applicant's parent, grandparent, guardian, Coach or Athletic Director must be a Lifetime Voting Member of the Saginaw County Sports Hall of Fame.

Instructions:

Applicant must fill out the Female Athlete Camp Scholarship Application and include a thorough essay response along with a one-page letter of recommendation from their coach or athletic director.

Guidelines:

- Must be a female Saginaw County High School freshman, sophomore or junior playing a freshman, junior varsity or varsity sport.
- The applicant's parent, grandparent, guardian, Coach or Athletic Director must be a Lifetime Voting Member of the Saginaw County Sports Hall of Fame.
- Past recipients of the camp scholarship are not eligible to win again.
- Each committee member will read each application and accompanying letter of recommendation. Applicants will be rated on a scale of 1 to 10 in four areas: participation, leadership, performance and community. Each area will be weighted equally and added together for a total score. A score of 40 is the highest possible score.
- Forms must be completed and postmarked by May 24, 2019.
- Complete forms using ink, typewriter or computer printout.
