Christ

A Greek translation of a Hebrew word “Messiah”

“We have found the Messiah, which is, being interpreted, the Christ” (John 1:41)

= Messiah

The Hebrew word for “anointed”

“Thus saith the Lord to His anointed...” (Isaiah 45:1)
literally – “Thus saith the Lord to His messiah...”

= Anointed

Examples of the Lord’s anointed in OT include...

King Saul, King David, Persian King Cyrus
(1 Samuel 16:6; 24:6; Isaiah 45:1)

= God’s Chosen

kingly aspect
chosen to carry out God’s purposes
subject to God’s will
