City Council Minutes

October 4, 2021

The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:34 p.m., in the City Hall. Elmer Boecker, Ron Doll, Shawn Duevel, and Kurt Thelen were present. Sandy Zierden was absent.

On a motion by Kurt Thelen, seconded by Ron Doll, minutes from September 7, 2021 were approved.

Waste/Water Operator, Tom Valerius reported that in September 2024 will test for lead and copper again. It's every 3 years. A resident wants to get water and sewer hooked bank up to the creamery. What are the costs? 1 meter did not read correct. Electrical work was done and it was unhooked. Data is stored in meter and should read everything next month. Samples and New Munich Meats was done. North and South ponds have about 6 inches of sludge. Will need to wait for the results to come back from the sonar boat test. Tom plans to shut water off for the ballfield coming up.
