

Spay? Neuter?

I don't want to do that to my pet!

Really? You don't want to improve your pet's quality of life and increase its lifespan?

- Neutered male cats live 62% longer than unneutered male cats.
- Spayed female cats live 39% longer than unspayed female cats.
- Neutered male dogs live 18% longer than unneutered male dogs.
- Spayed female dogs live 23% longer than unspayed female dogs.

*State Of Pet Health 2013 Report

- Over 80% of unneutered male dogs develop prostate problems.
- Dogs spayed before the first heat cycle have .5% chance of developing mammary tumors.
- Dogs spayed after the first heat cycle have an 8% chance of developing mammary tumors.
- Dogs spayed after the second heat cycle have a 26% chance of developing mammary tumors.

Not to mention perianal tumors (triggered by testosterone) and pyometra (almost always fatal without expensive and complicated surgery.)

Wise up, pet owners. Failing to spay or neuter your animals carries much more risk than just unwanted litters.
