Regular Meeting-----April 19, 1982

The minutes of the April 5, 1982 meeting was read by Donna Jo Koskinen. A Motion by Curtis Young and seconded by George White to approve the minutes as read. MOTION CARRIED.

MINUTES

David discussed with the Board about a check for \$500.00 for Moab Irrigation Company to help pay the Irrigation Company's expense to have Jim Walker check the flow on the mountain once a week this summer. The Board approved this check.

MOAB IRRIGATION COMPANY

The Financial Statement was discussed by the Board. D.L. Taylor asked about the liability of \$39,881.00 listed as Irrigation Connection Fees. David will talk Margaret and give the Board an answer next meeting.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The Board discussed the equipping of the wells. All Board Members are in favor of having a stand-by well for George White Well #4.

EQUIPPING THE WELLS

The suggestions by Rhodes Bros and Terry Del'Andrae are as follows:

1. Take the 75 HP motor and pump and column from Betty Schumaker Well #1, replace bowls and install in George White Well #4.
 - a. The Board agrees that the District should have a back-up well before pulling the pump and motor out of Betty Schumaker Well #1.
 - b. The Board wants to review the conditions from the State Health Department before using GWW #3 as a back-up well.

Everett Schumaker suggested that the District buy a 75 HP submersible pump and put a 40 HP motor in Betty Schumaker Well #1.

SUBMERSIBLE PUMP

The Board discussed the interconnection of the District culinary Main to the Corbin Well. The Board felt that this would cost too much.
