Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and East District Commissioner, Garry McFee welcomed those in attendance and then Kyle Carroll led the group in prayer followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

In attendance today were Larry Tiller, Mark Murphy, Henry Murphy and Monica Murphy. Today it was announced with the attendance of Henry Murphy it marked a 3rd generation Murphy to visit the DeKalb County Commission. County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised the following: Sunset Nursing Home was at full capacity, Riley's bid was an issue with supplier giving an incorrect cost on material but that Riley's were going to stand by the original bid, Sales tax reports were presented and reviewed, the date for the NW Commissioner's Meeting and who would attend was determined. The Commission was also informed that an employee whom had resigned had been over paid. The employee has since returned the overpayment to the Clerk's office. The Commission signed the corrected payroll statement.

At 10 a.m. bids were opened on brush to be removed on the Joan Trussell property in Dallas Township. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to accept the lowest bid from Journey Farms in the amount of \$2,250.00. East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the second. Motion carried.

Nate Zoschke and Abigayil Russ with McBride, Lock and Associates met with the Commission to do their exit interview in which they advised was one of the cleanest audits they have ever done. They will get a draft to the County by the middle of July and then the State will have the official audit back to the County by middle of August. The issues that were discussed was the budget process, adopting a policy for investments and sole source procedures. The Commission commends all office holders for a job well done.
