

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BACKFLOW PREVENTION/CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL POLICY FOR THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Purpose.

The purpose of adopting a backflow prevention/cross connection control policy is:

- a) for the protection of public potable water supply from the introduction of actual and potential contaminants or pollutants should backflow occur;
- b) to promote the elimination, containment, isolation or control of existing cross-connections, actual or potential, between public potable and non-potable water systems and plumbing fixtures; and
- c) to provide for the maintenance of a continuing program of backflow prevention and cross-connection control which will systemically and effectively prevent the contamination or pollution of all potable water systems.

SECTION 2. Backflow Prevention Device.

- a) Any backflow prevention device used shall be of a model or construction approved by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
- b) Backflow prevention devices shall be properly installed and maintained to protect the water system so as not to create a hazard to health.


SECTION 3. Type of Protection Needed.

The type of protection required shall depend on the degree of hazard that exists. A state approved air-gap separation, a state approved reduced pressure principle backflow prevention device or a state approved double check valve assembly shall be installed where the public potable water system may be contaminated with a substance that could cause a system or health hazard.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Chairman.
