#### What is a Will?

A Will (Last Will and Testament) is a legal document that details how your property will be distributed after your death.

A Will allows you to name your personal representative(s) who will represent your estate after your death and carry out the wishes you have stated in your Will. A Will also allows you to name a guardian for any children who are minors at the time of your death.

In addition to a Will, it is important to think about what you would want to happen if you were no longer able to make personal or financial decisions in the event you become seriously ill or injured. Whereas a Will comes into effect on your death, a Personal Directive and Enduring Power of Attorney can ensure your wishes are followed while you are still alive but unable to make decisions.

#### What is a Personal Directive?

A Personal Directive allows you to name a decision maker and/or provide written instructions to be followed when, due to illness or injury, you no longer have the capacity to make personal decisions such as where you will live or the medical treatment you will receive.

#### What is an Enduring Power of Attorney?

An Enduring Power of Attorney allows you to appoint someone to make financial and legal decisions on your behalf when, due to illness or injury, you no longer have the capacity to take care of things such as paying bills, dealing with buying or selling property, accessing your bank accounts, etc.

## Are you prepared?

A properly prepared estate plan allows you to direct where your property will go after your death. This important step can save a great deal of time, expense and stress for your family and loved ones during a time of grief. It is a good idea to consult with a lawyer to discuss your estate plan to ensure you have the appropriate documents in place to protect you and your property.

#### What is an Estate Planning Questionnaire?

The attached 12 page questionnaire is information that we need in order to prepare the documents for your Estate Planning Package. Simply complete this form the best you can and either drop off, mail, fax or scan and email this form back to us. We will then prepare draft documents for you to review and make any changes to before you meet with the lawyer. If you have any questions about the form or its contents, you can contact us anytime.

#### Why do we have our clients complete an information form before I see a lawyer?

By providing us with your information beforehand, we can have your Estate planning papers as close to completed as possible prior to you coming in to sign with the lawyer. We find this streamlines our process. We can address any concerns or make any changes prior to meeting with the lawyer and if you have any last minute changes, they can be made in the meeting with the lawyer before you sign off on any documents. If you have any questions or concerns at any time, you can contact Nadine or Jim.

#### How long does the process take?

Once we have your completed Estate Planning Questionnaire back from you, our goal is to have draft documents to you within 2 weeks. If you need documents on a rush basis, please let us know and we will do our very best to accommodate you. The actual signing of your Estate papers with the lawyer will take approximately 1 hour.

#### What forms of payment do you take?

We can accept cash, personal cheque, certified cheque or bank drafts at this time. We do not have the means for any forms of electronic payment. Payment is due upon signing of your Estate Documents.

#### Where do I keep my signed forms when I am finished at the lawyer's office?

We do not keep any of your original papers here at our office, You only sign ONE original Will. We recommend that you keep your Will and one copy each of your Personal Directive and Enduring Power of Attorney in a safety deposit box, fire safe or other safe location. Make sure your Executor(s) knows where your documents are located. You should also give a COPY of your will and an original of each Personal Directive and Enduring Power of Attorney to the person(s) you have chosen to be your Agent/Attorney.
