

# **WILLARD STURM**

## **1917 - 1995**

Willard Sturm, 78, Elkton Area businessman, died Friday morning, Dec. 1 at his home, following a short illness.

He was born April 1, 1917 in Winsor Township, son of the late Edward and Mary (Salzar) Sturm. On Nov. 25, 1947, he was united in marriage to Ann Bulstow in Bay City.

Mr. Sturm moved to Elkton in 1948 and farmed in Winsor Township all his life. In the early 1960s, he started Sturm Truck Parts, which he continued to operate until his recent illness.
