## Village of Innsbrook NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Village of Innsbrook Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, August 11, 2020, at 5:00 pm** located at Innsbrook Village Hall, 1835 Highway F, Innsbrook, Missouri. At said public hearing citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed to be set by the Village of Innsbrook, Missouri, a political subdivision. The tax rate shall be set to produce substantially the same revenues, which the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 shows to be required from property tax. Each tax rate is determined by dividing the amount of revenue required by the current assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 so the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation.
