Bishop's Annual Appeal: We ask you to please take a moment pray for the Bishop's Annual Appeal and the vital ministries it supports. Every dollar raised goes directly to ministries that support our Catholic faith and is not used for any other purpose.

Individuals who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 are no longer required to wear masks for parish indoor events and gatherings, including Mass, Bishop Donald Kettler said in a May 14 letter to pastors. Those who aren't vaccinated, however, are strongly encouraged to continue wearing masks indoors for their safety and the safety of others, he added. The guidance is in line with new protocols announced May 13 by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Gov. Tim Walz subsequently issued an executive order adopting the new guidance for Minnesota. Additional protocol changes in the diocese are set to take effect later this month. In his letter, Bishop Kettler again stressed the importance of people receiving a COVID-19 vaccination when it is available to them to keep the state and diocese on the right track for ending the pandemic. "I can't emphasize enough how important this is for keeping everyone healthy," he said. "Vaccinations are key to making continued progress against the virus and ensuring a safe return to worship and parish life. I agree with Pope Francis who has said that everyone should receive the vaccine, because not receiving it not only puts one's own life at risk but also the lives of others." Sunday Mass obligation remains suspended until further notice, he said.
