Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, December 19th

New Orleans Bowl - Caesars Superdome - New Orleans, LA

† **Georgia Southern 27 Sam Houston State 21.** This is the first bowl game in Sam Houston's history so they should be excited. The problem is that their head coach KC Keeler left for Temple. Sam Houston has 10 starters in the portal but the expectation is that many will still play. Georgia Southern has had minimal opt outs. Sam Houston is better in the stats (+0.3 vs -1.1 in ypp margin) but Georgia Southern played the more difficult schedule (No. 73 vs No. 116). We bet Georgia Southern on the open but don't have a strong recommendation at current.

Friday, December 20th

Cure Bowl - Camping World Stadium - Orlando, FL

† **Ohio 29 Jacksonville State 26.** Both teams have interim coaches so a really tough handicap here. Ohio is the better team in the stats (+1.3 vs +1.0 in ypp margin) and the two teams played similar strength of schedules. Jacksonville State has had many more players hit the portal so far and that's why the Bobcats have taken some money in the market. We haven't bet side or total but would lean with Jacksonville State at current.

Gasparilla Bowl - Raymond James Stadium - Tampa, FL

† **Florida 32 Tulane 19.** Florida closed the season strong including a 8-1 ATS mark in their last 9. Tulane is the better team in the stats (+1.4 vs +0.9 in ypp margin) but Florida played the much tougher schedule (No. 3 vs No. 80). Tulane starting QB Mensah left for Duke and Ty Thompson will get the start here even though he is in the portal. We think UF will have the big crowd edge. We prefer the OVER here.

NOTRE DAME 30 Indiana 23. First CFB playoff game on a college campus. Neither team has played a tough schedule (ND SOS No. 55 vs IND No. 68). However, statistically these two are dominant as Indiana is No. 1 in the country in scoring margin (+28.6) while ND is No. 2 (+26.2). Indiana is No. 3 in ypp margin (+2.5) while ND is No. 6 (+2.2). ND's strength is their rush offense led by RB Love while Indiana is No. 1 in the country in rush defense. Indiana is 9-3 ATS with an average cover of 14.1 ppg while ND is 10-2 ATS with an average cover of 11.0 ppg. Tough fading either at this point. We lean OVER despite the chilly forecast.

Saturday, December 21st

PENN STATE 31 Smu 22. Both teams lost their conference championship games. Penn State is the better team in the stats (+2.2 vs +1.7) and played the tougher schedule (No. 36 vs No. 64). Generally, we feel the Penn State defense is OVERRATED but they should be able to get pressure here vs an average SMU OL. Will the moment be too big for SMU? They played tight early vs Clemson before settling in. Last we checked, SMU isn't in the Top 5 so James Franklin usually takes care of business in these types of games.

TEXAS 33 Clemson 19. Texas is much better in the stats (+2.3 vs +0.9 in ypp margin) and played the much tougher schedule (No. 13 vs No. 52). Clemson played 4 Top 15 teams this year. They lost by 31 to Georgia, lost by 12 at home to Louisville, got upset at home to South Carolina and while they upset SMU in the ACC Championship game, they were outgained by 133 yards. Texas gets back LT Kelvin Banks here and has one of, if not the best defense in the country. Can Quinn Ewers take care of the football and can Texas be better in the red zone (No. 92)? We like Texas.

OHIO STATE 27 Tennessee 20. The best matchup in the first round. The Buckeyes come in off of the shocking upset loss to Michigan as Ryan Day and Chip Kelly's offensive gameplan to run it at Michigan's interior DL failed. One the other side, Ohio State is No. 1 in total defense and scoring defense but in their two losses (Oregon and Michigan) they allowed multiple long drives late in the game. Tennessee's strength is their RB Dylan Sampson and their DL. However, their offense was noticeably worse in SEC play compared to a weak non-conference slate (averaged 595 ypp and 62 ppg in non-conf vs 398 ypp and 25 ppg in SEC play). We're not sure we can trust Tennessee QB lamaleava yet in this spot.

Monday, December 23rd

Myrtle Beach Bowl - Brooks Stadium - Conway, SC

Utsa 31 COASTAL CAROLINA 23. Coastal is playing at home for this bowl game but the Chanticleers are up against it. They've lost 29 players to the transfer portal (more than any bowl team) and 11 of them are starters. They will be down to a 3rd string QB as well. We bet them on the opener as they are +0.1 in ypp margin (UTSA 0.0) and played a tougher schedule than UTSA (No. 96 vs No. 107). Safe to say, that was a horrific bet with opt outs.

Potato Bowl - Albertson's Stadium - Boise, ID

† **Northern Illinois 21 Fresno State 18.** Northern Illinois was the better team in the stats (+0.8 vs +0.5 in ypp margin) but Fresno did play the tougher schedule (No. 83 vs No. 115). Both teams have seen their starting QB's hit the transfer portal. While NIU has had 6 starters hit the portal, Fresno has had 10. That makes it a pretty tough handicap. We are confident that NIU's No. 5 defense allowing 281 ypp is the best unit on the field. The UNDER might be the only thing worth a look here.

Tuesday, December 24th

Hawaii Bowl - Ching Complex - Honolulu, HI

† **San Jose State 31 South Florida 28.** Neither team has had many opt outs. San Jose State was the much better team in the stats (+1.1 vs -0.1 in ypp margin) and played a slightly tougher schedule (No. 94 vs No. 103). It's a homecoming for San Jose State head coach Ken Niumatalolo who was born in Hawaii, played QB for Hawaii and started his coaching career at Hawaii. Many San Jose State players also have experience dealing with the islands distractions since they played in this bowl game last year. We think San Jose St is the right side but need a -2.5 to appear.

Betting CFB Openers (Note I have bet both sides/totals to a few games due to injury and opt outs)

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is the first book in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). HOME TEAM IN CAPS

L.A. CHARGERS 22 Denver 20. If the playoffs started today, the Broncos would be the No. 6 seed while the Chargers would be the No. 7 seed. Both are safe for now with Indianapolis, Miami and Cincinnati all sitting at 6-8. The Chargers are off arguably their worst performance of the season, a 40-17 loss to Tampa Bay as a 3-point home favorite. Denver continues to win and cover as the Broncos are now an NFL-best 11-3 ATS with 5 straight (one of those losses was a 23-16 loss at home to LAC on October 13 as a 3-point home underdog). With a low total, we think the Broncos would be a good first teaser leg up to +8.5.

Saturday, December 21st

KANSAS CITY 21 Houston 20. How about the NFL putting a couple of games on network TV opposite the CFB Playoffs? Will be interesting to see the ratings (we expect the NFL to dominate). Obviously, the story-line here is the health of KC QB Mahomes who for what seems like the 10th year in a row has an foot/leg injury late in the season. He was full participant in Tuesday's practice. The Chiefs broke their 7-game ATS losing streak in a 21-7 win over Cleveland last week. The Chiefs are closing in on the No. 1 seed yet again while Houston has clinched the division. Houston is better in ypp margin and played a tougher schedule. We lean with them here.

BALTIMORE 25 Pittsburgh 19. These two played a month ago with Pittsburgh winning 18-16 as 3-point home underdogs. Statistically, Baltimore is the best team in the NFL ranking No. 1 in ypp margin and No. 1 in DVOA. The Ravens covered the biggest point spread in the NFL this season last week in a 35-14 blowout of the Giants (-16.5). Meanwhile, Pittsburgh is -0.2 in ypp margin (No. 19) and the Steelers were exposed by the superior Eagles last week. We lean UNDER.

Sunday, December 22nd

CINCINNATI 27 Cleveland 18. We've been saying this for awhile now but Cincinnati is better than their 6-8 record. The Bengals are an above-average team in the stats and our power ratings. They're taking on a Cleveland team that ranks No. 30 in ypp margin and No. 31 in DVOA. The Browns are 4-10 ATS and RB Nick Chubb is now on IR. Cincy won the earlier meeting 21-14 as 5-point road favorites on October 20th. Obviously, Cincinnati in a 6-point teaser down to -1.5 makes a lot of sense.

DETROIT 27 Chicago 21. The Lions are having one of their best seasons in franchise history and it could go all up in smoke due to a massive amount of injuries. RB David Montgomery was the latest to go down last week and will be out for the season (knee). DT Alim McNeill tore his ACL and CB Carlton Davis fractured his jaw. That's now 12 players on IR for them. Even with the injuries, they should have enough to beat a pathetic Chicago team that has lost 8 straight (2-5-1 ATS).

Arizona 26 CAROLINA 21. Carolina failed their first favorite role in two seasons miserably in a 30-14 loss to the Cowboys last week. That ended a 5-game ATS win streak. They're now back in their preferred underdog role. The Cardinals are on the outside looking in when it comes to the playoffs. They took care of business last week at home vs the Patriots. Statistically, Arizona remains impressive as they are No. 9 in ypp margin despite playing one of the toughest schedules. We lean Cardinals.

BUFFALO 31 New England 17. Buffalo is firmly entrenched in the No. 2 seed but it looks like they won't be able to catch the Chiefs despite owning the tie-breaker over them. They pulled the outright upset over Detroit last week and close with two games vs the lowly Pats and also the Jets next week. Obviously the Pats are a bottom-5 team just playing out the season. How much motivation does Buffalo have to get margin?

Philadelphia 24 WASHINGTON 21. Obviously, Philadelphia has a commanding 3-game lead over Washington in the division. The Eagles beat the Commanders 26-18 (-4.5) back on November 14th. With Detroit's injuries, the Eagles are also

now thinking about getting the possible No. 1 seed in the NFC. Meanwhile, the Commanders won last week but their backers were left scratching their heads after they nearly blew a 17-0 lead in New Orleans. Philly is the better team in the stats and played the tougher schedule.

ATLANTA 25 N.Y. Giants 17. The Giants were in the biggest underdog role of the entire NFL season last week and still couldn't cover in a 35-14 home loss to Baltimore. They are now 1-8 ATS in their last 9 and rank No. 31 in ypp margin. The Giants are taking on an Atlanta team that pulled a stunner this week benching Kirk Cousins in favor of Michael Penix. We're in "wait and see" mode before we could recommend betting Atlanta with this kind of number.

INDIANAPOLIS 24 Tennessee 20. The Titans are an NFL-worst 2-12 ATS, one of the worst marks in recent NFL history. Yet, they continue to take money in the market including this week with this line down from +4.5. The Titans do have the better ypp margin and it will be interesting to see how the Colts respond after last week's loss to the Broncos nearly sealed their playoff fate. We're passing for now.

L.A. Rams 25 N.Y. JETS 23. The Rams come in having extra rest after upsetting the 49ers last Thursday. Neither team scored a TD in the 12-6 L.A. win. That's 3 straight wins and covers for the Rams who would be the No. 4 seed in the NFC if the season ended today. The Jets are playing better as of late particularly on offense as they scored a season-high 32 points in the win at Jacksonville. The Jets have the better ypp margin (+0.2 vs -0.3) and we lean with them here.

Minnesota 23 SEATTLE 22. With Detroit's injuries, Minnesota now has a shot at getting not only the division but the No. 1 seed in the NFC. Right now, though they would be the No. 5 seed despite a 12-2 record. The Vikings are 9-4-1 ATS and rank No. 7 in ypp margin. Seattle is now on the outside looking in as far as the playoffs after last week's 30-13 home loss to the Packers. You would think they'd be in store for a bounce-back here. We like the spot catching Minny on a short week and traveling.

MIAMI 21 San Francisco 20. Both teams have had extremely disappointing seasons and both will likely be sitting at home for the playoffs. The 49ers have extra time to prep after an embarrassing 12-6 loss to the Rams at home. Meanwhile, Miami's offense also floundered in their 20-12 loss to the Texans. SF is still No. 2 in ypp margin for the season while Miami is No. 19. We don't expect to be involved on the side but would lean with the UNDER considering the offensive woes.

LAS VEGAS 21 Jacksonville 20. One of the worst match-ups of the entire NFL season with the two teams combining for a 5-23 record. Jacksonville has at least showed more grit as the Jags are 5-2-1 ATS in their last 8. The same can't be said for the Raiders who have lost 10 straight games and are 3-6-1 ATS in those 10. If these two teams were playing in our backyard, we'd close the blinds. No interest.

Tampa Bay 27 DALLAS 23. Tampa Bay is rolling right now having won 4 straight games. Last week's 40-17 win at the Chargers as 3-point underdogs was arguably their best performance of the season. If the season ended today, Tampa Bay would be the No. 3 seed in the NFC. Meanwhile, Dallas has not given up on the season despite their 6-8 record. They got an easy win and cover at Carolina last week. We like the OVER.

Monday, December 23rd

GREEN BAY 28 New Orleans 14. If the season ended today, Green Bay would be the No. 6 seed in the NFC despite a 10-4 record. That's what happens when you are in the same division as the Lions and Vikings. The Packers would be favored over the Bucs or Rams if they do go on the road in the first round. They're taking on a New Orleans team who somehow rallied from a 17-0 deficit to almost pulling the stunner over Washington last week (thanks to an officiating time error). Spencer Rattler will likely get the start here. We're not interested.
