

The Friends of Pennypacker Mills cordially invite you to participate in our 15th Annual Craft Marketplace at Pennypacker Mills, to be held on Saturday, September 19, 2026, at 5 Haldeman Road, Schwenksville from 9:30 AM to 3 PM.

During the event, we provide coffee to get you started in the morning, and booth coverage for solo vendors when you need a break. Restrooms are in the building adjacent to the Craft Marketplace. The Fitzwater Station food truck also will be on site.

We have **111 spaces** to rent out on a **first-come**, **first-served basis**. We keep a waiting list, and we do call up quite a few folks from that list. Nevertheless, it is smart to sign up early as we usually sell out by March.

We have a few options:

- You can rent a vendor space only and provide your own 10' x 10' tent (preferred).
- You can reserve a space under our tent space (limited to 23 spaces).
- You can rent an 8-foot table to add to either type of space (limited to 14 tables).

Everyone must provide their own chairs.

Registration is non-refundable.

This is the Friends' primary fundraising event. The profits from it benefit Pennypacker Mills, a popular Montgomery County-owned historical site which is located at the intersections of Routes 29 and 73 in Schwenksville. It is open to the public and visited annually by over 15,000 people. The Friends' sole purpose is to assist and support the mission and activities of Pennypacker Mills by working in cooperation with the site staff, Montgomery County, and other interested parties.

Established in 2010, our non-profit group has held many fund-raising activities which enabled the purchase of a pump for the History Center, the acquisition of Galusha Pennypacker artifacts, the paint analysis needed to restore the servant area, refurbishing the main parking lot garden beds, creation of a video tour of the second floor so that the handicapped who cannot climb our stairs are able to virtually enjoy the experience, and the purchase of a number of informational signs located at places of interest around the site. We also sponsor many events at the site.

We seek, and our visitors have come to expect, vendors who are truly artisans – makers of beautiful items from raw materials. We have potters, glass artisans, woodworkers, sewists, jewelry makers, knitters and crocheters, paper crafters, painters, photographers, a blacksmith, beekeepers, soap and candle makers, bakers, canners, creative upcyclers, and more.

This event is not for you if:

- 1. You make 3D-printed items.
- 2. You use a die-cutting machine (e.g., Cricut) and a hot press to place slogans on pre-purchased garments, or stickers onto cups, trays, etc.
- 3. Your crafts are assembled from pre-made items purchased at a craft store with minimal modifications or additions made by you.
