When you read these scriptures, read them out loud so they can enter your heart. It is through the hearing of the Word of God that it becomes food to your spirit man.

Faith, strength and peace can then rise from your heart and you will be able to "Have the Mind of Christ".

Genesis 22:14 (ESV)

So Abraham called the name of that place, "The Lord will provide"; as it is said to this day, "On the mount of the Lord it shall be provided."

Numbers 6:24 (ESV)

The Lord bless you and keep you;

Deuteronomy 14:22-23 (ESV)

"You shall tithe all the yield of your seed that comes from the field year by year. And before the LORD your God, in the place that he will choose, to make his name dwell there, you shall eat the tithe of your grain, of your wine, and of your oil, and the firstborn of your herd and flock, that you may learn to fear the LORD your God always.

Deuteronomy 28:1- 14 (ESV)

"And if you faithfully obey the voice of the LORD your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the LORD your God. Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the field. Blessed shall be the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your cattle, the increase of your herds and the young of your flock. Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl. Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out. "The LORD will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before you. They shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways. The LORD will command the blessing on you in your barns and in all that you undertake. And he will bless you in the land that the LORD your God is giving you. The LORD will establish you as a people holy to himself, as he has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the LORD your God and walk in his ways. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

Psalm 24:1 (ESV)

A Psalm of David. The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof, the world and those who dwell therein,

Psalm 27:7-8 (ESV)

Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud; be gracious to me and answer me! You have said, "Seek my face." My heart says to you, "Your face, Lord, do I seek."

Psalm 34:10 (ESV)

The young lions suffer want and hunger; but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing.

Psalm 35:27 (ESV)

Let those who delight in my righteousness shout for joy and be glad and say evermore, "Great is the Lord, who delights in the welfare of his servant!"

Psalm 37:4 (ESV)

Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.

Psalm 37:25-26 (ESV)

I have been young, and now am old, yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken or his children begging for bread. He is ever lending generously, and his children become a blessing.

Proverbs 2:1-5 (ESV)

My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you, making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding; yes, if you call out for insight and raise your voice for understanding, if you seek it like silver and search for it as for hidden treasures, then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God.

Proverbs 3:9 (ESV)

Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the first fruits of all your produce;

Proverbs 13:22 (ESV)

A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, but the sinner's wealth is laid up for the righteous.

Proverbs 21:20 (ESV)

Precious treasure and oil are in a wise man's dwelling, but a foolish man devours it.

Proverbs 22:7 (ESV)

The rich rules over the poor, and the borrower is the slave of the lender.

Isaiah 49:25 (ESV)

For thus says the Lord: "Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken, and the prey of the tyrant be rescued, for I will contend with those who contend with you, and I will save your children.

Jeremiah 17:5-8 (ESV)

Thus says the Lord: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart turns away from the Lord. He is like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see any good come.
