We have identified six major areas of concern the foundation will address.....

- 1. Support educational and social needs of the communities within the ten southern counties of New Mexico.
- 2. Support proficiency in English, both written and spoken, as a matter of social justice and economic advancement.
- 3. Support the education of future generations by awarding scholarships and working with colleges, universities and vocational/technical schools.
- 4. Support, in the tradition of the Second Vatican Council, adult faith formation of laity, religious and clerics serving the Roman Catholic Diocese of Las Cruces, New Mexico.
- 5. Support religious retirement situations and religious communities, such as, by way of example and not by way of exclusion, Seton Hill University and the Sisters of Charity.
- 6. Support the parishes of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Las Cruces in meeting infrastructure and material needs.
