

## NOTICE OF VIOLATION: CHEMICAL MONITORING

The CITY OF CISCO, PWS ID TX0670001, has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public Water Systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers and report the results of the monitoring to the TCEQ on a regular basis. Additionally, Public Water Systems that use a series of treatment processes that includes coagulation, flocculation, sedimentation or clarification and filtration as part of the overall treatment protocol must monitor Total Organic Carbon and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a monthly basis.

We failed to monitor and/or report the following constituents: TOTAL ORGANIC CARBON, CHLORITE & CHLORINE DIOXIDE

This violation occurred in the monitoring period in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2022 (**September 2022**).

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether your drinking water is safe from chemical contamination and protected from potential adverse health effects associated with disinfectants and disinfection by-products. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for chemical constituents and disinfectant by-product precursors, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the Total Organic Carbon levels in or the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The reports were submitted to TCEQ, however, they were not submitted timely as required by Title 30, Texas Administration Code (30 TAC). Although the reports were submitted in an untimely manner, all data provided to TCEQ was within normal limits for treated water. All employees have been informed of the deadline for submitting timely reports and no additional violations have been reported since September 2022.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
