

Costume information for the Starlet Christmas Show 2022

- Please arrive at the theatre ready to perform with your hair done and stage makeup applied. No one will have time to help you do your hair and makeup. Hair should be pulled up and neatly styled, usually in a bun.
- If you are wearing a headpiece, please secure it with bobby pins. Preferably, pins should be the same shade as the hair. Do not use barrettes, combs, or hair picks unless part of the headpiece.
- Let your tights be your undergarment. Panties under a costume or tights are unsightly. Please have either a new or freshly laundered pair of tights and clean shoes for performances.
- Do not change the costume in any way. Wear it as instructed by the Costume Mistresses.
- Costumes will be at the theatre prior to the performance. Signs will direct you to your designated dressing area and your costume.
- Specifics
 - Chinese Girls, Spanish, Flowers and Candy Cans: Wear white or pink tights and “clean” pink ballet slippers.
 - Chinese Girls: Wear hair in a tight, well-sprayed bun as hairpiece consists of 2 decorated chopsticks.
 - Women and girls ages 7 and older – Use full-stage makeup for the performances. Full-stage make up includes but is not limited to: foundation, eyebrow pencil, eye shadow, mascara, eyeliner, blush, and red lipstick. A moderate use of glitter in the hair and on the face and body is acceptable.
- No jewelry on any body part that is visible to the audience (except as provided by Starlet).
- No colored nail polish.
- No temporary tattoos or body art. If a permanent tattoo is in an area visible to the audience, please cover with pancake makeup or makeup intended to conceal tattoos. Please do not cover the tattoo with a bandage.
- **Absolutely no costumes are allowed in the audience.** Remember that the general public is paying to see the performance. Therefore, costumes should only be seen on stage, during the performance. **All costumes and headpieces are the property of Starlet Dance Studio and will be used for future performances so please take care of your costume. Handle it responsibly – don't step on it, sit on the floor in it, eat in it, etc. - and put it back the way that you found it.** Do not leave the theatre with your costume.
- Help us maintain the professional look of our production by staying out of the wings until your dance.
- **Please do not eat or drink beverages when wearing your costume.**
- Remember to smile, smile, smile and have fun. You are wonderful!!
