**2020-2021 School Dress Codes and Guidelines**

Victory Christian School dress codes and guidelines are practical and economical, while holding to the biblical standard of modesty:

***Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.***

**1 Timothy 4:12**

***I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. **Dress Code for Girls (first through twelfth grades):**

Skirts & Jumpers	Black, blue, gray, or khaki skirts and/or jumpers to the knee (should cover the knee when sitting) may be worn. For grades Pre-K through third, polo-style dresses may be worn at appropriate length and fit. No denim is allowed.
Pants	Black, blue, gray, or khaki school uniform-type pants may be worn. Capri pants are not allowed. Pants must be loose fitting. There must be 3" of ease at hips. Without stretching fabric, it should be easy to pinch a fold on each side. Pleats are recommended but not required. No denim is allowed.
Shorts	Black, blue, gray, or khaki school uniform-type shorts may be worn. Shorts must be loose fitting. There must be 3" of ease at hips. No denim is allowed. Shorts must meet or exceed inseam guidelines according to grade. (3K-5 th grades must wear a 7" inseam; 6th -12th must wear 8" inseam)
Tops	Any solid color polo or oxford button-down shirts may be worn. Shirts must be loose fitting. There must be 3" of ease at the bust. Belts Belts should be worn when belt loops are present. No obscene (i.e. writing) or dangerous (i.e. spikes) belts may be worn.
Hair	Hair must be a natural color. No punk or faddish hairstyles: hair must be feminine.
Waist	Pants, skirts, and shorts must be worn with waist at small of back. Buy tall sizes if necessary to accomplish this.
Shoes	Shoes must be closed-toe. No flip flops or slides are allowed.
Jewelry	No visible body piercings (other than ears).
Hats & Head coverings	No hats or head coverings may be worn during school hours (including lunch, PE, or breaks).
Spirit Wear	Spirit Wear may be worn on Fridays and when special permission has been given by the administration. Overall Appearance Attire must present a traditional uniform appearance. All clothing must be worn in the usual fashion.

### **Dress Code for Boys (first through twelfth grades):**

Pants	Black, blue, gray, or khaki school uniform-type pants may be worn. Pants must be loose fitting and straight leg. No denim is allowed. Without stretching fabric, it should be easy to pinch a fold on each side. Pleats are recommended but not required.
Shorts	Black, blue, gray, or khaki school uniform-type shorts may be worn. No denim is allowed. Shorts must be loose fitting. Shorts must meet or exceed inseam guidelines according to grade. (3K-5th grades must wear a 7" inseam; 6th -12th must wear 8" inseam)
Tops	Any solid color polo or oxford button-down shirts may be worn. Shirts must be loose fitting. Without stretching fabric, it should be easy to pinch a fold on each side.
Belts	Belts should be worn when belt loops are present. No obscene (i.e. writing) or dangerous (i.e. spikes) belts may be worn.
Shoes	Shoes must be closed-toe. No flip flops or slides allowed.
Hair	Boy's hair must be groomed in a traditional fashion. Hair must not touch the back of the collar. Hair must be a natural color. No punk or faddish hairstyles: hair must be masculine. Boy's must be clean shaven.
Waist	Pants and shorts must be worn with waist at small of back. Buy tall sizes if necessary to accomplish this.
Jewelry	Boy's may wear no piercings.
Hats & Head Coverings	No hats or head coverings may be worn during school hours (including lunch, PE, or breaks).
Spirit Wear	Spirit Wear may be worn on Fridays and when special permission has been given by the administration. Overall Appearance Attire must present a traditional uniform appearance. All clothing must be worn in the usual fashion.

### **Physical Education and VCS Athletics Dress Guidelines (all grades):**

Tops	A t-shirt with sleeves must be worn for all PE and VCS Athletic activities unless special permission has been given by the administration. No offensive logos are allowed.
Bottoms	Athletic shorts, skorts, or loose-fitting warm-up pants may be worn for PE and VCS Athletics. Shorts and skorts must meet or exceed inseam guidelines according to grade. (3K-5 th grades must wear a 7" inseam; 6th -12th must wear 8" inseam)
Shoes	Athletic shoes with non-marking soles are to be worn on the gym floor. Improper shoes will result in students and athletes not participation in activities (with a 0 grade assigned for graded activities).
Hats & Head Coverings	No hats should be worn unless special permission has been given by the administration (i.e. baseball practice).
