Professional Development Workshop Conducting Workshop

Target Population: K-12 Music Educators

Materials: Digital videocamera, blank tapes, select list of repertoire

appropriate for K-12 orchestra, band, vocal ensembles.

Objectives/Outcomes:

1. Develop fluency of beat patterns and meters.

- 2. Gain control in conducting various dynamics and tempi.
- 3. Achieve ease and grace in cueing.
- 4. Gain control and proper use of the left hand.
- 5. Develop effective body and facial language.
- 6. Develop aural analysis and error identification skills.
- 7. Learn traditional forms and conducting of select representative repertoire.
- 8. Combine elements into dynamic conducting.

Procedures:

- 1. Music educators (ME) will be guided through methods for effective score study and marking.
- 2. ME will participate in group practice of scores through singing, piano interpretation, and gesture.
- 3. ME will be videotaped conducting workshop participants in workshop repertoire.
- 4. ME will have one-on-one sessions with workshop leader analyzing the videotapes with appropriate rubric.

Assessment:

- 1. Analysis of videotaped rehearsals by workshop leader.
- 2. ME will also engage in self-assessment of technical and musical conducting abilities as demonstrated in the videotape
