## Re-opening of Church for worship under National Recovery Plan Phase 3

While there is no need for pre-registration, <u>ONLY FULLY VACCINATED</u> parishioners are allowed to attend subject to the following and any other conditions issued by MKN/MNU.

- > All who attend MUST have MySejahtera's status showing low risk and fully vaccinated.
- > Temperature 37.5degrees Celcius and below with NO flu symptoms, cough or cold
- > All must check-in using MySejahtera App.
- > To wear face mask at all times
- Maintain social distancing of minimum 1 metre
- > Sanitizing of hands before entering church

Church gates will be opened from 4.45pm to 5.15pm on Saturdays and on Sundays from 7.15am to 7.45am.
