DESCRIPTION: This is a very attractive partially refinished BP Stallion hunting bow. If you want a higher poundage longer bow that is smooth and forgiving, this is a good choice. The Stallion was one grade below the Mustang, but steps above the Javelina, Hunter and Colt respectively. Bubinga riser. Comfortable pistol grip. Green face limbs and Crimson back limbs. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; a few light superficial stress lines. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in good condition.

Comes with a new string.

Note: I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 18 hours) to see if the old glues would hold and if any
