Your November 2021 bill will reflect the new rates.

Effective October 1st, **you will only be billed for the water you use** at a per a thousand gallon rate.

### Compare past bills

The City of Cascade bills water and sewer on the same bill. These costs are roughly 50 / 50 plus charges for the water that you use.
