The Corolle Baby Doll Bib and Diaper



These instructions were written as part of an effort to give Baby Dolls and accessories to young patients in hospitals. The bibs and diapers are made from flannel.

Please respect intellectual property; do not post this pattern on your website, blog or other electronic media without the express written permission of the designer, when identified, or Stitchin' for Kids.

Note:

- 1. Your printer settings affect the size the pattern prints out.
- 2. Be sure your printer is set on "Print Actual" before you print.
- 3. If you don't have "Print Actual" as an option, try a different browser, for example, switch from Explorer to Chrome.
- 4. Print the pattern.
- 5. Compare the one inch measurement on the pattern to your own ruler. If the measurements don't agree, please make the appropriate adjustment to the pattern by enlarging or reducing it.

REQUIREMENTS:

Bib: 1/4 yard each of two complementary flannel fabrics (will make several Bibs)

1" piece of 3/4" Velcro

Diaper: 1/4 yard of fun printed flannel (will make several Diapers)

1/4 yard white flannel (diaper inside fabric)

2 one inch pieces of 3/4" Velcro

ASSUMPTIONS:

All Seams are 1/4"

PREPARATION:

Bib: Cut pattern twice; once in each fabric.

Diaper: Cut pattern twice; once in print flannel and once in white.

CONSTRUCTION:

Bib: Pin the two pieces of fabric right sides together. Stitch around the entire perimeter leaving a 2" opening for turning. Press lightly, clip inside curve and clip/pink outside curves. Then turn Bib right side out through the opening.

Push out all corners, folding in the seam allowances at the opening.

Press again, being sure that the fold is exactly on the seam line. Top stitch 1/8" from the edge all the way around, closing the opening as you sew.

Sew the Velcro to the top tabs of the Bib.

Diaper:

Pin the two pieces of fabric right sides together. Stitch around the entire perimeter leaving a 2" opening for turning. Press lightly, clip inside curves and clip/pink outside curves. Turn Diaper right side out through the opening.

Push out all corners, folding in the seam allowances at the opening.

Press again, being sure that the fold is exactly on the seam line. Top stitch 1/8" from the edge all the way around, closing the opening as you sew.

Sew the Velcro to the tabs and the matching pieces to the body as indicated on the pattern.
