**INSTRUMENT RENTALS**

1) If you plan to turn in your rental instrument at the end of this season, you must do so after the April 24<sup>th</sup> concert. You will need a copy of your paperwork when you turn in the instrument to make sure Mrs. Savage has accounted for your instrument return.

2) If you wish to continue renting the instrument throughout the summer, you will need to fill out another instrument rental agreement form and provide that to Mrs. Savage. The fee for summer rental is \$100.00.

3) If there are any damages to the instrument, you must list that damage on a paper inside the case. Of course, you are responsible for damages per your rental contract.
