"Navigating Challenging Behaviors in Preschool" Approval # CWO-157164

Content Description

Complicated preschool behaviors can be overwhelming for teachers and disruptive to classroom functioning. A toolbox of classroom strategies can help teachers support all children for success. This workshop will provide support strategies for children who are reluctant, are boisterous, have emotional or motor dysregulation, or have sensory issues. As a result of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- 1) Identify when and why a specific behavior is problematic
- 2) Identify classroom strategies for supporting children with challenging profiles

- 3) Anticipate and plan for challenging behaviors during group learning activities
- 4) Review the value of universal design in teaching preschool children
- 5) Transfer effective tools and strategies to parents and caregivers

Brief Biography of Presenter

Sally Neuberger LCSW-C has been providing clinical and consultation services to children, families and schools for the past 30 years. Her experience with children and their families has spanned developmental clinics, medical resident training programs, maternal child health programs, and schools for children with special needs. From 1991-2015, Ms. Neuberger created and supervised a counseling department at a Prek-12 school for children with special needs. During that time., Ms. Neuberger presented 3-5 annual MSDE approved workshops for teachers and early education specialists. Ms. Neuberger presently maintains a private clinical practice, provides potty coaching services throughout the country, and continues to offer workshops and provide classroom consultation services to preschool and elementary level teachers.
