

"Blueprint for the Future"

Dear Church Family,



As your pastor, I'm excited to share with you about an upcoming worship series that speaks directly to our current journey. This July, both Bethany and St. Andrew's UMCs will explore "God's Grand Design" - a four-week series that helps us understand and celebrate God's timing in bringing our congregations into partnership.

Just as an architect carefully designs each building for its unique purpose while considering how it connects with surrounding structures, God has been preparing our churches for this new season of ministry. Each congregation will maintain its distinct identity and worship style - after all, God's creativity is seen in diversity, not uniformity! Yet we'll discover how sharing a pastor and certain ministry opportunities can strengthen both churches' witness in our community.

The series unfolds like a master blueprint:

Week 1: "Divine Timing" (July 6) We'll explore how God's timing, while sometimes surprising, is always perfect. Using the metaphor of architectural planning, we'll see how God prepares us for new seasons of ministry.

Week 2: "Unexpected Connections" (July 13) Like Paul's unexpected call to Macedonia, we'll discover how God sometimes creates surprising partnerships that enhance our ministry.

Week 3: "God's Blueprint for Unity" (July 20) We'll examine how God's design for unity doesn't mean uniformity. Each congregation maintains its unique characteristics while finding strength in connection.

Week 4: "Building God's Kingdom Together" (July 27) Using Nehemiah's wall-builders as inspiration, we'll celebrate how different groups working on their own sections contributed to one greater purpose.

Throughout this series, both congregations will share some common elements - including weekly prayers for each other - while maintaining our separate worship services and unique identities. Think of it as neighboring houses on God's street, each with its own character but connected in purpose and community.

I believe God has exciting plans for both congregations as we enter this new chapter. While change can feel uncertain, remember that the Master Architect sees the complete design. As Jeremiah 29:11 reminds us, "'For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the LORD, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

I invite you to join me on this journey of discovery. Let's approach this new season with open hearts, eager to see how God's grand design unfolds in our church families.







New Business
