### GREAT NEWS A BIG STEP AHEAD!

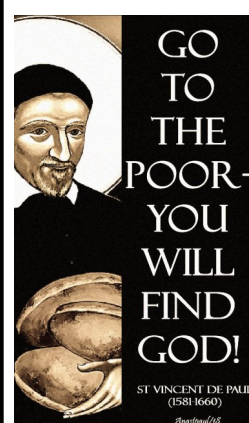
**Beginning next weekend March 20/21+ reservations will no longer be required to attend Masses or other**

### ST. LOUISE DE MARILLAC Feast Day March 15

In Louise's day, serving the needs of the poor was usually a luxury only fine ladies could afford. Her mentor, Saint Vincent de Paul, wisely realized that women of peasant stock could reach poor people more effectively. Only over a long period did he come to realize that she was the answer to his prayers. She was intelligent, self-effacing, and had physical strength and endurance that belied her continuing feeble health. Her rented home in Paris became the training center for those accepted for the service of the sick and poor. "Your convent," St. Vincent said, "will be the house of the sick; your cell, a hired room; your chapel, the parish church; your cloister, the streets of the city or the wards of the hospital." The Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul was the result. Thank you St. Louise!
