STAGE 2

PROHIBITS:



● IGNITING, BUILDING, MAINTAINING, OR USING A FIRE, INCLUDING FIRES FUELED BY COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS SUCH AS WOOD, CHARCOAL, BRIQUETTES, AND/OR COAL.

Exemption: Using a stove, wood pellet smoker, grill, fire ring, or other manufactured device that is fueled solely by LPG fuels that can be turned on/off switch are allowed within a Developed Site.

● SMOKING OUTDOORS.

Exemption: Smoking within an enclosed vehicle or Developed Site.

● USE OF EXPLOSIVE TARGETS, TRACER ROUNDS, OR INCENDIARY AMMUNITION.

STAGE 2

PROHIBITS:



● USE OF INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES FOR COMMON HOUSEHOLD-ONLY ACTIVITIES, SUCH AS LANDSCAPING OR PROPERTY MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.

Exemption: Operating internal combustion engines with spark arresting devices when the use is for common household-only activities such as landscaping, property maintenance and repair.

● OUTDOOR MECHANICAL AND INDUSTRIAL OPERATIONS SUCH AS WELDING AND/OR THE USE OF ACETYLENE OR OTHER TORCH WITH AN OPEN FLAME.

STAGE 2

EXEMPTION:



USING A STOVE, WOOD PELLET SMOKER, GRILL, FIRE RING, OR OTHER MANUFACTURED DEVICE FUELED SOLELY BY PRESSURIZED LIQUID PETROLEUM OR LIQUID PETROLEUM GAS (LPG) FUELS THAT CAN BE TURNED ON AND TURNED OFF PROVIDED THE DEVICE IS LOCATED IN A DEVELOPED SITE.

STAGE 2

EXEMPTION:



OPERATING INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES WITH SPARK ARRESTING DEVICES WHEN THE USE IS FOR COMMON HOUSEHOLD-ONLY ACTIVITIES SUCH AS LANDSCAPING, PROPERTY MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.

PROHIBITS:



IGNITING, BUILDING, MAINTAINING, OR USING A FIRE, INCLUDING FIRES FUELED BY COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS.

PROHIBITS:



OUTDOOR MECHANICAL AND INDUSTRIAL OPERATIONS SUCH AS WELDING AND/OR THE USE OF ACETYLENE OR OTHER TORCH WITH AN OPEN FLAME.
