From Nina: nothing new on fall members show. All arrangements have been finalized. Information is available on the website.

From Chris: members Spring Show opens Friday May 5th at Gallery 22. That's a first Friday in Delaware and should provide a lot of foot traffic. Take in is May 2nd and 3rd from 6:00-8:00 PM. Contact an OPAL friend and arrange for them to take your pieces for you, if you can't make the take in times. If you don't have any friends;) and all else fails, contact Chris!! Theme is "Hues of Imagination". Artist's reception is Friday June 2nd 6:00-8:30 PM. Gallery 22 will provide a meat and cheese tray, participating artists will provide appetizers, desserts and beverages. Bob Sako has scheduled Vasiliev Nini as Juror for the show. He is a sculptor, painter and instructor at The Cultural Arts Center in Columbus. Take down is on June 25th. Take down times will be announced later.

Pertain announced that only six people have signed up for the Cris Ivers work shop in May. We need 10 more participants in order to break even. The workshop information has been shared with other art groups but there's been no response. It will have to be cancelled or possibly changed to a different length of time and format, zoom maybe. Pertain will contact Chris regarding options. Members present were asked to comment on why they thought there was low interest in the workshop. Comments were the cost, conflicting schedules, length of time (2 days) too long, preference of zoom to in person, air travel inconsistencies and hotel booking and costs.
