

# **ANNA ROPP**

## **1899 - 1995**

Anna Ropp, 90 of Bad Axe for the past 58 years, died Saturday morning, Nov. 25 at Four Seasons Health Care Center, Bad Axe.

She was born Jan. 12, 1899 in Pigeon, daughter of the late Peter and Catherine Ropp. She and Emanuel Ropp were married in December, 1919 in Pigeon. He preceded her in death on March 17, 1989.
