(February 23, 1948 - January 4, 2011)

Bryan R. Nicholas age 62, of Elkton former Laker custodian died Tuesday morning, January 4, at Bay Regional Medical Center. He was born February 23, 1948 in Detroit to Robert and Lorraine (Crist) Nicholas. They lived in Davenport, Iowa until 1955, when they moved to Pinnebog Rd. in Colfax Twp.
