

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for the Lake Village Water Association

Our water system violated a drinking water requirement during the past year. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customer, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the incident.

**We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During compliance period 07/01/2019 – 09/30/2019 we did monitor and collect the required numbers of samples, but the results were not reported to the Division of Water within the monitoring period timeframe. **

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly report during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for Haloacetic Acids and Trihalomethanes, the number of samples we are supposed to take, the number of samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which samples were taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples were taken
Haloacetic Acids	2 per quarter	2	7/1/19-9/30/19	9/24/19
Trihalomethanes	2 per quarter	2	7/1/19-9/30/19	9/24/19

What is being done?

The sample results were immediately reported to the Division of Water upon notification that the sample results were not reported. For all future samples, the Association will confirm that the results are reported to the Division of Water within the required monitoring period.
