Guest speaker: Adrian Martinez from the Austin Fire Department shared fire safety information:

- The fire department can provide smoke detectors. Call 512-974-0299 to request.
- Be safe when frying a turkey by making sure the turkey is completely thawed; testing the amount of oil need using a cold pot an water.
- If case of a stove fire, turn off the heat and deprive the fire of oxygen by closing the oven door or covering the pot with a lid.
- Don't use water an a grease fire! Use an approved fire extinguisher. Baking soda is an option if you don't have an extinguisher.
- Check the gauge and the expirations date on your fire extinguisher to make sure it is still in working order.
- Test your smoke detectors twice a year, and replace them after ten years.
