Director Young moved that the board make a request to the County Board of Commissioners for operating funds in the amount of \$1,500.00. Seconded by Director Norman. MOTION CARRIED.

It was agreed that the County Board of Commissioners should be asked to improve the "Old Mail Trail Road" which would provide access to the area of the Plainfield Reservoir.
