Reimbursements: If you need to be reimbursed for out-of-pocket expenses, please use the new Check Request Form, which is available in the mailbox cabinet in the office, as before. When you've completed a form, just staple the receipts and turn it into the Rector's mailbox. You no longer need to find two signatures.

Bills/Invoices: For direct payment to vendors, please obtain from them an invoice. Then, simply write your name on the invoice and turn it into the Rector's mailbox. Do write your name, though, so Dan can follow-up with you if needed.
