- Palate: Luscious and full-bodied, featuring flavors of black cherry, pomegranate, and subtle spice, supported by a smooth, lingering finish.
- Finish: Long and harmonious, with a balance of fruit and oak.
- Aging Potential: Enjoy now or cellar for up to 5-7 years.
