This is the BIGGEST NEWS in Albuquerque New Mexico! <u>The National Senior Games</u> are being held here next summer, 2019!

#### To qualify as an athlete in your sport for next year (2019), you MUST participate in the STATE GAMES THIS YEAR! August 24 - 26, 2018

For softball, the qualifying is two-fold. First, all **players** must qualify in 2018 in a **STATE GAME** and on a **TEAM** that places 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in their bracket. You have options if you cannot qualify in New Mexico. For example, there's Mesquite, Nevada, the Huntsman Senior World Games in St. George, Utah and the Phoenix Winter Games in November 2018. Once you are a **qualified NSGA** softball player you are eligible to play in the **National Games** here in Albuquerque in 2019.

Go to the National website <u>http://nsga.com/states</u> for specific tournament information, or to post yourself to join a team.

**National rules read**: In order for a team to compete, they must medal 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in their age bracket in a state tournament. The roster for these "winning" teams, feeds over and is tracked by Nationals. In the past, I have seen the "roster rule" totally eliminated (I

think to get more teams to compete in Nationals). A roster may have up to 20 players. A team can pick up qualified players to fill out their rosters. Some players may be eligible to play on an older bracket team. For example, a player turns 55 in 2019. She qualified on a 50's team in 2018. For the 2019 Nationals, she can choose to play with the 50's or be picked up by a 55's team. Qualified players may prefer to play "down" on a younger team. The age bracket is determined by the



youngest player on a team.

So now you know. Pick up the pace on practice! Take part in other tournaments so you are "on your game"! And we'll see you playing ball in Albuquerque in 2019. **Shirley Johnson**
